Did you know?...

- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help cover the cost of gear, such as uniforms, pads and helmets for all players. These items are NOT funded by the High School, Anchorage School District or the State of Alaska. Our program does not receive ANY money from ASD. Our program is funded by boosters and parent contributions. For example, three years ago we purchased forty (40) new helmets which cost upwards of \$10,500.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help to cover the cost of all training equipment (e.g., blocking sleds) and other essentials that the team needs to physically prepare and compete in Alaska and out-of-state.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help to reduce the out-of-pocket cost per player for Player Equipment Packs.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help provide for the video equipment and video analysis software, HUDL, for breaking down South and competitor's game video, including the creation and distribution of college recruiting highlight videos.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help to cover the purchase and maintenance of the necessary communication equipment that the coaches use at game time.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club fees help to pay for team dinners, motor coach travel out of town and the annual End-of Season Banquet.
- The 12th Wolverine Booster Club does NOT receive any money from the ticket gate. Those funds are collected by the school and used at their discretion.
